

## 5 Easy Steps for Recycling Plastic Baler Twine

Please ensure hay free deliveries

This easy method keeps twine clean and won't break apart your bale.

1. Hold knot and cut twine close by (both twines separately)
2. Hold knot and pull clean twine through bale
3. Clean off hay or debris (recycler may refuse if not totally hay free)
4. Store twine on hook, posts or in a clean dry bag etc. pls separate colours
5. Deliver to designated collection site or recycling depots
